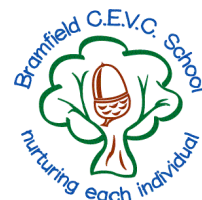


Bramfield Out of School Club - Information for Parents



The Bramfield Out of School Club officially opened in April 08, in response to a need identified by (working) parents for childcare before and after school, and is continuing to develop the service it provides to the community.

It is registered by Ofsted to cater for up to 16 children from 4-11 years (older brothers and sisters - up to age 11, are very welcome to come along).

From Jan 09, for parents of 4 yr olds needing all day care from 8-6 pm, links can be made with Stepping Stones pre-school (based adjacent to school site) to achieve this. (We are hoping to develop this for younger pre-school children over the next year).

Ofsted visited on 21/10/08 and after only 6 months, gave the setting a 'GOOD' grading!

- The aim of the club is to provide before and after school childcare in a relaxed atmosphere. Children are able to use the school grounds to play in, use the computers and take part in a variety of activities, including art, craft and games.
- A simple breakfast and after-school snack are provided.
- The club is based in the area that is used as Foundation room and extension during the day. It has its own entrance, toilet facilities, phone, and from June 08, its own kitchenette area.
- The area benefits from being part of the school, in that the procedures, policies and checks that apply to the school apply here too. (A booklet of policy documents relating to the Out of School Club, is available in the club - ask the playleader).
- Play leaders are Anna Frost and Craig Warwick, who also run the Stepping Stones Pre-School. Diane Bond as an assistant. Two staff will be involved in each session.. Please note that the play-leaders will be responsible for care of children in sessions, but the school office will administrate on bookings, fees, queries.
- The Club is managed by a committee from Bramfield School Governing Body which includes headteacher, 2 governors and administrator.

Registration and Booking Sessions If you are interested in using this facility you will need to complete a registration form for your child/children available from the school office. Sessions can be booked on monthly forms which are held in the club, school office and on school blog, or for odd days by phoning Anna and Craig on 01986-784586 or the school office on 01986-784205

- If your child has special needs please check with the school office, so that we can make necessary arrangements

Payment of Fees:

Fees are calculated to cover staffing costs for each session, and are in line with other local provision.

- After school club: £3.00 per hour (calculated on $\frac{1}{2}$ hours)
- Breakfast club is £3.00 and includes cost of breakfast.
- Families with 3 children are offered a concession of 'pay for 2 and the third gets in free!'
- We would appreciate fees being paid to the school office with the monthly booking form,
- Occasional users can pay per session - please give the money to the playleader in a named envelope.
